Chemurgic's 3-18-18 Liquid Fertilizer may be used at any time to correct plant nutrient deficiencies and maintain vigorous growth. Recommended rates are listed, but may vary depending on crop conditions and cultural practices.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Fertigation: Inject *Chemurgic's 3-18-18 Liquid Fertilizer* into the irrigation lines after filters. Thoroughly clean irrigation lines and system after injection of *Chemurgic's 3-18-18 Liquid Fertilizer* by flushing irrigation lines and system with clean water prior to turning off pumps.

RECOMMENDED RATES

Trees and Vines: Apply at 2 to 15 gallons per acre every 10 to 14 days based on crop requirements.

Vegetable and Row Crops: Apply at 2 to 15 gallons per acre per application based on crop requirements.

Note: *Chemurgic's 3-18-18 Liquid Fertilizer* may cause spotting on plant tissue because of the high pH.

FOLIAR APPLICATIONS

Note: *Chemurgic's 3-18-18 Liquid Fertilizer* should be applied in the late evening or early morning.

DO NOT spray in the heat of the day.

DO NOT spray when the plant is under moisture stress.

DO NOT spray to the point of runoff.

Allow 3 to 4 hours after application before sprinkler irrigation to avoid washing the product off. **Field and Row Crops, Vegetables and Fruit Crops:** Apply at 2 to 6 guarts per acre. Adjust

rates according to severity of deficiency symptoms and/or weather extremes.

Orchards, Vineyards: Apply rate of 2 to 6 quarts per acre. Adjust rates according to severity of deficiency symptoms and/or weather extremes

MIXING

Precaution: Mixing with hard water may cause clogging of the lines due to calcium, magnesium and iron in the water combining with *Chemurgic's 3-18-18 Liquid Fertilizer*.

When tank mixing with other products, "jar test" proportionally mixed components to confirm compatibility.
